ELIGIBILITY:

1. An applicant must be a natural child, stepchild, legal ward, a legally adopted child, Brother, sister, niece, nephew, or grandchild of a member of Local 9158, who has Been in good standing for six months prior to the scholarship drawing:
2. Recipients of awards must be presently attending or accepted into a grammar School [grades 1-8]; High School or accredited school at the graduate or undergraduate level. The scholarship is for the school semester beginning **January** of the **Next school year of the awarded scholarship**
3. A recipient is only eligible to receive an award **once** in each category.
4. **Each Local 9158 member is entitled to submit only one application per year provided he or she meets the eligibility requirements.**
5. The drawing will be held at the Local 9158 Octobers monthly membership meeting on each year.
6. SENA 9158 Members or their spouses are not eligible to win a Scholarship's.

Awards:

1. Thirty two [32] scholarships will be awarded in the following amounts:

\$ 500.00	Grammar School	[8] awards
\$1,000.00	High School	[8] awards
\$1,500.00	College Level	[16] awards
2. Each award will be made directly to the school for tuition, room and board, or any other directly related school expense. Under **no** circumstances will the award be paid directly to the recipient.
3. Payment award will be made directly to the school at the beginning of January provided the student has successfully completed his or her first semester, or in the case of "Technical Schools", upon the completion of half of the course.
4. The school will be instructed to credit the student's account for any award amount that exceeds the amount due the school.
5. Students in Public Schools are not eligible for scholarships school must be fee based
6. Incomplete applications will be rejected
